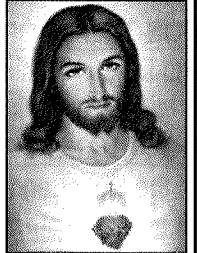

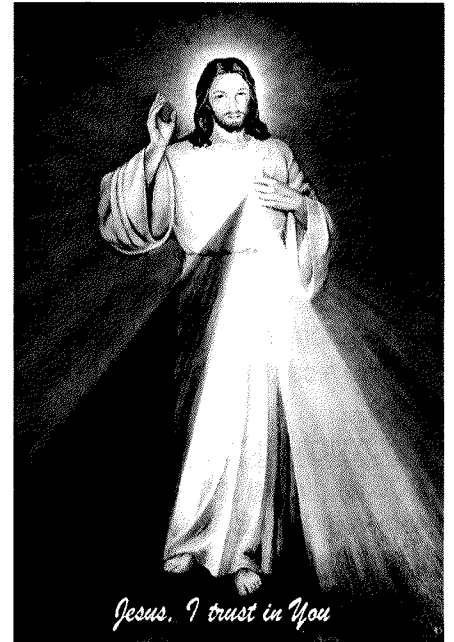

**SUNDAY, APRIL 19, IS DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY.**

A plenary indulgence can be obtained on Divine Mercy Sunday even with the coronavirus restrictions. To receive the indulgence, recite the Our Father and the Creed before an image of Our Merciful Lord Jesus and pray the prayer "Merciful Jesus, I trust in you." In addition to this, say a prayer for the Pope. The other requirements of going to Confession and receiving Holy Communion can be completed in the future as soon as it is possible for you.
