



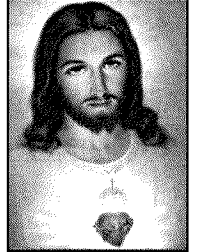

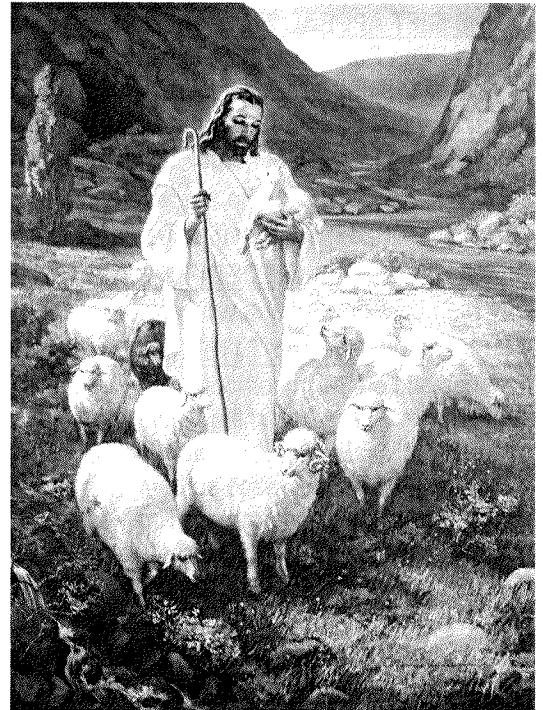
One Flock:
