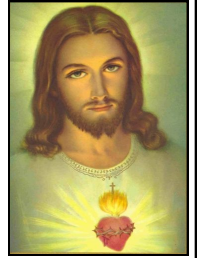

NEW DIRECTIVES have been issued by the Diocese of Fargo concerning the COVID-19 health crisis. Please read the attached letter to the bulletin.

Public Masses can begin again starting on May 4. Attendance is optional and everyone is **still dispensed** from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation during the COVID-19 health crisis.

Social distancing guidelines will need to be followed by those who choose to attend Mass. Since attendance is still optional, you are responsible for assessing the risk to yourself. You are asked to wear a mask during the Mass.

Households of people may sit together, but separate household must be 6 feet from each other. This will greatly limit the number of people who can fit in the churches. Minto has 26 pews and Warsaw has 52 pews that are available for each Mass.

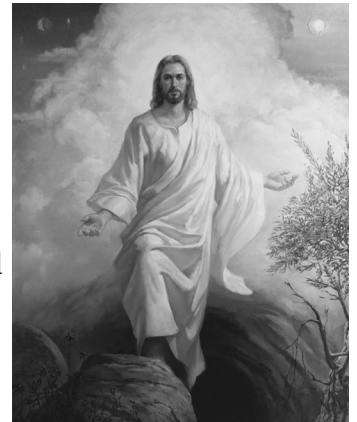
Until we get a feel for the capacity and demand, we will be filling up the pews from the front to the back. We will leave the church from the back to the front. You will not be able to sit wherever you want.

Since you will be seated in every other pew, Fr. Moen will go through the pews for Holy Communion. During this extraordinary time, Holy Communion can only be received on the hand during Mass.

FR. MOEN WILL BE VIDEO RECORDING THE WEEKEND MASS on Saturday evenings and posting it on the parishes' Facebook page and website. Also Fr. Moen has recorded a Holy Hour in the Divine Mercy Adoration Chapel and posted it.

CONFESSIONS will be available at Minto in the church on Saturdays from 3:45-4:55pm, 1/2 hour before weekday and Sunday Mass, and anytime — just call, and at Warsaw 1/2 hour before Sunday Mass in one of the classrooms in the church basement.

MASS INTENTIONS on May 2, 3, and 4 will be offered by Fr. Moen in private Masses. Masses starting Tuesday, May 5, will be open to the public following the directives issued by the Diocese of Fargo.
