



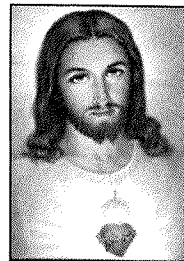

POPE FRANCIS - GENERAL AUDIENCE - Wednesday, 23 October 2019

Dear Brothers and Sisters: In our catechesis on the Acts of the Apostles, we now consider Saint Paul's first missionary journey. Following a fierce persecution, Paul and Barnabas – prompted by the Holy Spirit – set off to spread the Gospel abroad. As a result, the Good News was also preached to the Gentiles. This initially caused a lively controversy, as to whether a strict adherence to the Mosaic Law was required of these converts. To discern God's will in these matters, the Apostles gathered in Jerusalem, and came to a new and shared understanding. The "Council of Jerusalem" shows us that the way of resolving issues among Christians is an attentive listening to others, yet always under the guidance of the Holy Spirit. Let us pray that God will strengthen in us the desire to embrace the path of dialogue and to listen patiently to one another and to the voice of the Lord.

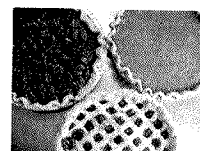

INDULGENCES FOR THE SOULS IN PURGATORY: A plenary indulgence for the Souls in Purgatory can be gained by the faithful who (1) on any and each day from Nov. 1 – 8 devoutly visit a cemetery and pray for the departed. (2) On All Souls' Day (Nov. 2), devoutly visit a church and recite an Our Father and the Creed. In addition to these actions, the normal three conditions must also be fulfilled. For each indulgence, you must pray for the Pope (Our Father and Hail Mary), receive Holy Communion, and go to Confession within several days (about 20 before or after the indulgence). The confession can apply to multiple indulgences.

MILITARY COLLECTION: The collection for the Archdiocese for the Military Services in the Diocese of Fargo is Sunday, November 3. This is a collection that is taken every three years. Established by St. John Paul II in 1985, the AMS is the only U.S. diocese responsible for providing pastoral care to men and women serving in the U.S. Armed Forces, enrolled at a U.S. Military Academy, being treated as a patient at any of the 153 U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs Medical Centers, or working for the federal government beyond U.S. borders—including those from our own parish and diocese. Including families, AMS priests and deacons serve approximately 1.8 million Catholics who hail from 50 states and U.S. territories. While the salaries and retirement of Catholic military chaplains are paid for by the U.S. Government, the AMS does not receive any funding from the government or military for program and administrative costs.
