



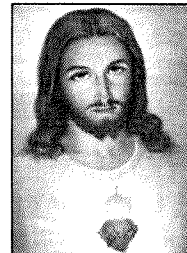

The Law of Love: Dr. Scott Hahn Reflects on the Thirty-first Sunday in Ordinary Time

Love is the only law we are to live by. And love is the fulfillment of the Law that God reveals through Moses in today's First Reading. The unity of God—the truth that He is one God, Father, Son, and Spirit—means that we must love Him with one love, a love that serves Him with all our hearts and minds, souls and strength.

We love Him because He has loved us first. We love our neighbor because we can't love the God we haven't seen unless we love those made in His image and likeness, whom we have seen. And we are called to imitate the love that Christ showed us in laying His life down on the Cross. As we hear in today's Epistle, by His perfect sacrifice on the Cross, He once and for all makes it possible for us to approach God.

There is no greater love than to lay down your life. This is perhaps why Jesus tells the scribe in today's Gospel that he is not far from the kingdom of God.

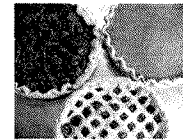
We are called today to examine our hearts. Do we have other loves that get in the way of our love for God? Do we love others as Jesus has loved us? Do we love our enemies and pray for those who oppose and persecute us?

Let us tell the Lord we love Him, as we do in today's Psalm. And let us take His Word to heart, that we might prosper and have life eternal in His kingdom, the heavenly homeland flowing with milk and honey.

INDULGENCES FOR THE SOULS IN PURGATORY: A plenary indulgence, applicable only to the souls in Purgatory, can be gained by the faithful who (1) on any and each day from Nov. 1 – 8 devoutly visit a cemetery and pray for the departed. (2) On All Souls' Day (Nov. 2), devoutly visit a church and recite an Our Father and the Creed. In addition to these actions, the normal three conditions must also be fulfilled. For each indulgence, you must pray for the Pope (Our Father and Hail Mary), receive Holy Communion, and go to Confession within several days (about 20 before or after the indulgence). The confession can apply to multiple indulgences.
